HOME ARTS EXHIBITS

General Rules and Regulations

- A. All classes are open to non-professional men and women.
- B. Children under the age of 18 may exhibit projects but are not eligible for awards or premiums.
- C. Entry forms are due by **June 19, 2009**. Two copies of the entry form must be submitted. Mail to:
 - Cumberland County Fair Association
 - P.O. Box 611
 - Bridgeton, NJ 08302.
- D. No entry fees will be charged.
- E. Every reasonable precaution is taken to protect entries while they are on the Fairgrounds, but all entries are at the risk of the exhibitor.
- F. One entry per class.
- G. Each exhibit must be in the quantity and number as required.
- H. Judges' decisions are final. Each entry is judged on its own merit.
- I. Ribbons will be awarded for each entry-Excellent, Very Good & Good.
Premiums will be awarded for each division. Best of Show-\$4;
1st-Place \$3; 2nd-Place \$2 & 3rd-Place \$1.
- J. Bring exhibits to the Home Arts Building on Sunday, July 5 between 12:00 Noon and 4:00 PM. Exception: All food must be dropped off on Monday, July 6, between 12:00 Noon and 2:00 PM. Judging begins Monday afternoon.
- K. All entries must be the result of this past year's work.
- L. Each item entered must have an exhibitors tag (available at

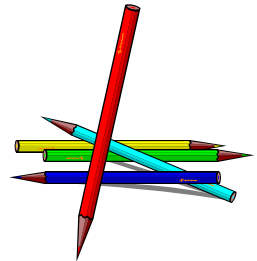

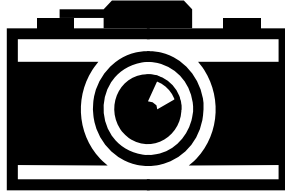
Photography Rules

- C. Plastic covering required to protect artwork.

Baked Goods Rules

- A. Cool baked goods before wrapping. Baked goods may be on paper plates. Be sure to put your name on bottom of pie tin or cake plate.
- B. Recipe should be included with all exhibits.
- C. Cakes for the decorated classes are to be entered on cardboard.
- D. To cut down on waste, we will display only a portion of the item. The rest may be picked up by the entrant after judging at 7 PM, Monday evening. The only exception will be decorated cakes.
- E. No mixes may be used.
